From Raleigh, NC

From I-40 East, merge onto Interstate 95 South via Exit 328A towards Benson/Fayetteville. Take US 74 East Exit (Exit 14) towards Maxton/Laurinburg. Bypass all Chadbourn exits. Bear right onto Union Valley Church Road Exit. Take a right onto Union Valley Church Road off the exit. Take a right on NC 130 West at stop sign. SCC is 1.1 miles on the right. (Approximately 2 hours, 9 minutes and 124.75 miles)

From Charlotte, NC

Take US 74 East towards Wilmington, NC. Bypass all Chadbourn exits. Take a right on NC 130 West at stop sign. SCC is 1.1 miles on the right. (Approximately 3 hours, 3 minutes and 145.33 miles)

From Wilmington, NC

Take US 74 West towards Leland/Bolton/Lake Waccamaw\Whiteville. Bypass ALL Whiteville exits Bear left onto Union Valley Church Road Exit. Turn left onto Union Valley Church Road Exit. Go to stop sign and a take a right onto NC 130 West. SCC is 1.1 miles on the right. (Approximately 1 hour, 8 minutes and 54.24 miles)

From Myrtle Beach, SC

Take US 17 North/US 17 Bypass North. Merge to Grissom Parkway North. Merge onto SC 31 North toward SC-9. Make a slight right onto SC-9 North. Merge onto US-701 North towards Tabor City, NC. Turn left onto NC 410 North, North of Tabor City. Follow NC 410 North to NC 130. Turn right onto NC 130 heading East. SCC is approximately 2 miles on the right). (Approximately 1 hour, 24 minutes and 57.34 miles)

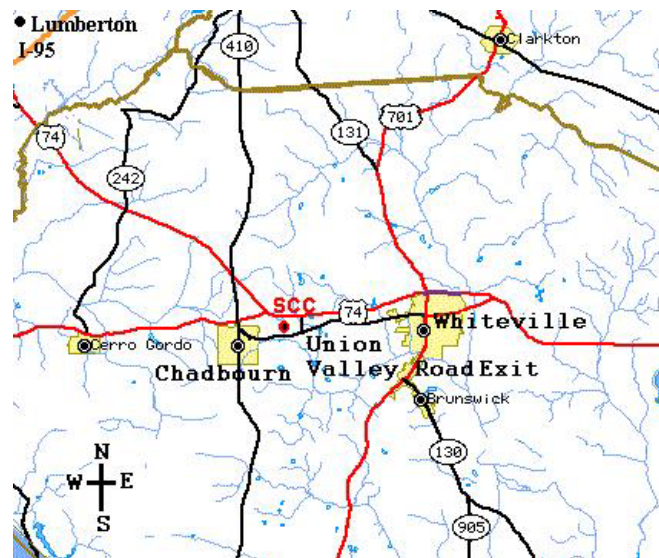

A - Offices of the President, Institutional Advancement/SCC Foundation, Curriculum Instruction, Cashier, Operations/Finance, JobLink Career Center, Student Development Services (Admissions, Counseling, Financial Aid, Public Information, and Registrar), Southeastern Early College High School, Information Technology Department, Upstairs Art Gallery, Information Highway classroom, classrooms/offices for business programs and college transfer.

B - Cosmetology, engineering and industrial programs, Basic Skills Lab (Adult Basic Education and General Education Development), Computer Lab, Electrical/Electronics Technology Program and classrooms.

C - Science and Environmental Science Technology classrooms, laboratories and offices.

D - Auditorium, Music classrooms and offices, college printing, and audiovisual facilities. Art classrooms (a studio for drawing, painting, sculpture, and pottery), Learning Technologies offices.

G - Student Center, Student Activities office, Food Services, the college's gymnasium, including well-equipped health/wellness laboratory and locker rooms, Forest Management Technology program, Talent Search and Upward Bound projects, classrooms and faculty/staff offices.

H - Early Childhood Education program/Child Development Center.

L - Library with spacious reading and study areas as well as two meeting rooms.

M - Multipurpose structure that houses offices for the Academic Skills Lab, RSVP, the Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration, Criminal Justice, Basic Law Enforcement Training and Welding programs, as well as data-processing classrooms and equipment and general purpose classrooms and meeting rooms.

N - SCC Bookstore, Medical Lab Technology, Phlebotomy and Pharmacy Technology programs classrooms and faculty offices.

R - Nursing and Allied Health Building.

S - Shipping/Receiving, Maintenance, Carpentry Shop.

T - Business and Industry Skills Training Center, Continuing Education Division, Small Business Center, and television production facility.
